James Salters days in film

James Salters was a pilot in the United States Air force. He abandoned the military profession in 1954 after the publication of his first novel, *The Hunters*. He is best known as a novelist, but during the sixties and seventies, he worked in film making.

Salters made documentaries, wrote text to films, and even was the director of a film called *Three*, starring Charlotte Rumppling and Sam Waterston.

In *Passionate falsehoods*, which was adapted from Salters book *Burning the days*, published in *The New Yorker* in 1994, Salters tells the story of his life in film.

Salters time in the film world is both good and bad. In Rome he met directors and stars. In New York he explored the city with Robert Redford and enjoyed being famous. Deborah Treisman and Michael Agger have talked about Salters. Nick Armstrong in *The Last Book* describes Salters opinion about his film career:
