2- Past Simple: They are actions or states that began and ended in a certain amount of time.

Past Continuous: It is used to declare actions that take place in the past.

Past Perfect Simple: It is used to express sequences or events in the past and to identify what happened first.

Past Perfect Continuous: This time is useful to define a continuous action in the past that happened before another.

Present Simple: This time is used to talk about actions that happen frequently, either daily or with specific periodicity.

Present Continuous: They are actions or states that happen continuously or that are carried out just at the moment in which it is spoken.

Present Perfect Simple

They are actions or states that began at some point in the past and that continue until the moment in which it is spoken

Present Perfect Continuous:

It is for actions or states that have developed for a certain time that began in the past and continues at the time it is expressed

Future Simple: With this time actions or states are expressed that are thought spontaneously and will happen in the future

Future Continuous: They are states or actions that will have progress in the future

Future Perfect Simple: These are states or actions that will be completed at some point in the future

Future Perfect Continuous: It serves to express actions or states that will occur in the future, as well as its conclusion

Past Perfect CONTINUOUS:

- They had been fishing
