Q. What is a connector? Give an example.

example:

- The film received good ratings; however, it was very long.
- Zoey loved hot chocolate, unlike John.

b. what is a linking word? give an example.

R- Linking words, also called connecting words, are words that you use to combine two different thoughts into one sentence. Each part of the final sentence is called a clause. A clause is a part of a sentence that has a subject and a verb.

example: • Take an umbrella in case it rains

- → ♥ ♥ ♥ ← •
- He is poor and has not house, but **even if** he had money, he wouldn't buy a house

c. what are the differences between connector and linking word.

When conjunctions are used, this implies that the statement after the conjunction is relating knowledge already known to the reader.

Connectors are used when the information is presented in the preceding sentences and is not assumed knowledge.
