The present perfect is formed from the present tense of the verb have and the Past Participle of a verb

we use the present perfect

+ for something that started in the past and continues in the present

- They've been married for nearly fifty years
- She has lived in Liverpool all her life

+ when we are talking about our experience up to the present

- I've seen that film before
- I've played the guitar ever since I was a teenager
- He has written three books and he is working on another one

Example: Mary has eaten meat.  
Mary has not eaten meat / Mary hasn't eaten meat.  
Has Mary eaten meat?

- Peter and Diego have eaten bread
- They have not eaten bread.  
Have they eaten bread?
