The first Ferris wheel was made by and named after
George Washington Gale Ferris Jr. He designed it for the
Chicago World's Fair in 1893. It was the tallest attraction
there, standing 264 feet high in 1893, anything that was
not turned by hand was considered a sight to see.
And the wheel, which was a machine, was truly incredible
to see. Further, as one visitor put it, the wheel was
amazing because it seemed to be missing support.
That is, it did not look like it could stand on its
own. And yet it did and even rotated.

They keep reaching higher and
brighter

Today's wheel technology has only improved since then. Most
of today's Ferris wheels are much larger than that first one.
The largest in the world is the Singapore Flyer, which
stands slightly taller than twice what Ferris did today.
The Ferris wheel is the most common amusement park ride,
but that does not mean you should take them for granted. Instead,
be thankful for Ferris' invention. The next time you're at an
amusement park, don't just look up at the impressive
wheel to the sky on your way to a newer attraction.
