She said that she liked ice cream

she said that she had taken English lessons before

she said that she would see me later

she said that she would help but ...

she said that she could speak perfect English

she said that she could swim when she was four

she said that she would come later

she said that she should call her mother

she said that might be late

she said that she must study at the weekend
