BE USED TO, USED TO, GET USED TO

BE USED TO

If you are used to something you have often done or experienced it; it is not strange, new or difficult for you.

STRUCTURE:

Be used to + noun phrase or verb (-ing form)

We can also say be used to someone

NEGATIVE: be not used to.

I am used to getting up early in the morning. I don't mind it.

He didn't complain about the neighbours' loud party - he was used to the noise.

I don't think Tom's strange - I'm used to him.

I don't understand him: I'm not used to his accent yet.

EXAMPLES:

- Speak French

I am used to speaking French

- Sleep early

She is used to sleeping early

- Read a book per month

I am used to reading a book per month

- Play guitar

I am used to playing guitar

- Travel abroad

I am used to traveling abroad

- Pay my bills

I am used to fighting with my friends

- Go to the shopping

I am used to going to the shopping

- Eat rice

I am used to eating rice

- Listen to the radio

I am used to listening to radio

GET USED TO

STRUCTURE:

- Get used to + something / someone

I got used to his Scottish accent after

a while

- Get used to + verb (-ing form)

I got used to waking up early in the morning

If you get used to something you become accustomed to it; it is no longer unusual or strange

Get used to is the process of becoming used to something

After a while he didn't mind the noise in the office; he got used to it

EXAMPLES:

- I am get used to speaking French

- She is get used to sleeping early

- I am get used to reading a book per month

- I am get used to playing guitar

- I am get used to traveling abroad

- I am get used to playing my bills

- I am get used to fighting with my friends

- I am get used to eating rice

- I am get used to listening to radio

USED TO

STRUCTURE:

Used to + verb infinitive refers to a habit or state in the past. It is used only in the past simple tenses.

PAST HABITS:

If you used to do something, you did it for a period of time in the past, but you don't do it any more.

PAST STATES:

We also say used to express a state that existed in the past but doesn't exist now.

States are NOT actions. We express states with stative verbs such as have, believe, know and like.

STRUCTURE - QUESTIONS:

did(n't) + subject + use to be

STRUCTURE - NEGATIVE:

subject + didn't + use to be

- I used to watch TV
- I didn't used to watch TV
- Did I used to watch TV?

- Students used to go to the school
- Students didn't used to go to the school
- Did students used to go the school?

EXAMPLES:

- I am used to speak French
- She is used to sleep early
- I am used to read a book per month
- I am used to play guitar
- I am used to travel abroad
- I am used to play my bills
- I am used to fight with my friends
- I am used to eat rice
- I am used to listen to radio

BE USED TO (Ser usado para)	Si esta acostumbrado a algo, lo ha hecho o experimentado con frecuencia; no es extraño, nuevo o difícil para ti.	Estoy acostumbrado a levantarme temprano por la mañana.
GET USED TO (Acostumbrarse a...)	Si te acostumbras a algo; ya no es inusual o extraño, es el proceso de acostumbrarse.	Me acostumbré a su acento después de un tiempo.
USED TO (Solía hacerlo)	Se refiere a un hábito en el pasado, si solía hacer algo, lo hizo durante un período de tiempo en el pasado, pero ya no lo hace.	Solíamos vivir allí cuando era niño.
