

Refusal

### EXAMPLE:

- You will travel to New York the next year (prediction).
- You are going to travel to New York the next year (plan).

Affirmative: Subject + will + verb (base form) + complement.

Negative: Subject + will not (won't) + verb (base form) + complement.

Question: Will + subject + verb (base form) + complement + ?
