Maria **has finally** (finally - reach) the top. She sits on her sled. She rides down the hill. Sparky runs beside the sled. They have finally reached the bottom. Sparky **has followed** (follow) Maria all the way down the hill. Sparky **has decided** (decide) that he likes the snow too!
