

• WHERE

It is used when we refer to a place and is placed after the noun referring to the place.



The box where the old toys are is in the garage.



The library where I used to go after school, is going to be restored.

• WHEN

It is used when we refer to a period of time. It is placed after the noun referring to the period of time.



I still remember the day when you proposed.



The year 2011, when I went to study abroad, was the best of my life.
