MODAL VERBS



All the auxiliary verbs except be, do and have are called modals. Unlike other auxiliary verbs All the auxiliary version their helping form; they cannot act alone as the main verb in a sentence.

The modal verbs express modality, ability, possibility, need or another condition. We use them for the future and the conditional.

As complementary verbs that are, modal verbs do not work As completely another verb. This other verb always follows the modal without and is in the base form (the infinitive without "to"). The werb and verbs are not conjugated and they have no time.
