Answer the questions

1) What is a connector? Give an example
By connectors are the words or expressions that allow us to indicate a relationship between two sentences. For example: but, and, although, also.

Depending on the type of connector, a different meaning is given to the connection that is established. It is important to know the functions of each connector to use it properly and link the different ideas of a text.

Examples:

- She plays the piano as well as the violin, guitar and drums.

- I like your dress, but I wouldn't pay for it.

- He is sick because yesterday he was playing in the rain.

2. What is a linking word?

↳ Linking words are words that are used to relate ideas or concepts within the same paragraph or sentence. They are linking elements. otherwise the applications could be changing the essential meaning of the phrase and causing confusion or understanding.

Examples:

▶ He could play the violin though he was only five years old

▶ She washes his new car whenever it gets mucky

▶ Remember that restaurant where you ate a huge steak

3. What are the difference between Connector and linking word.

R/ The difference between the two lies in the function they occupy in the sentence. On the one hand, connectors are conjunctions that join words or propositions (parts of speech) to each other. That is, they are normally used within the same sentence.

On the other hand, linkers are words or groups of words that connect phrases or ideas from the text. They are at the beginning of the sentence. They ensure that the text has a logical connection and guide the reader through it.

Really, knowing the difference is not relevant because the meaning they provide, whether they act as a connector or as a linker, is the same.
