

## TOO AND ENOUGH

Too: "Too" means more than what is needed

- It's **too** hot to wear that coat.
- I was driving **too** fast.

Too + Adv / Adv

Too much + uncountable Noun

- There is **too much** salt in this food.

Too Many + Countable Noun...

- There are **too many** students in this classroom

Adv / Adv + Enough

- He isn't old **enough** to watch this program
- We're not walking **quickly enough**

Enough + Noun.

- We have **enough** money
- I have not got **enough** money to buy this computer

## When are too and enough used?

### TOO (demasiado)

The particle *too* indicates excess, that is, the quantity or quality exceeds what is considered necessary.

### ENOUGH (suficiente / suficientemente / bastante)

The particle *enough* indicates that the quantity, number or quality of something is sufficient.
