1) Connectors are words or expressions that point to a relationship between two sentences

Ex: and - adding to the above - still - now -
although - but.

2) Are words of different categories (preposition, conjunctions, adverbs, verbs...) that are not concepts, they are used to join concepts and indicate the type of relationship established between them.

Ex among others, as, by, for, where.

3) Connectors these are words or groups of words that serve to link ideas by clearly expressing how they are related to each other. Their main function, as their name indicates, is to connect different parts of a text, whether they are words, sentences or even paragraphs.
