I always get hungry during classes

Water freezes if the temperature
goes below 0°C

If + present simple,
→ present simple

First conditional

If I have some free time,
I will watch Netflix

I will change the wifi
password

if you don't ~~do~~ your
homework

If + present simple,

1. Zero conditional

If + present simple, present simple

2 First Conditional

if present simple, future simple (will)

3 Second Conditional

if + past simple, would (infinitive verb)

4 Third Conditional

if + past perfect, would have (v. past participle form)

Zero and first conditional

1. My teacher gets angry, when I don't do my homework
2. My little sister cries if she will have a nightmare
3. When you drink too much alcohol, you will get drunk
4. If you mix blue and yellow, you will get green
5. If you don't drink enough water, you will become dehydrated
6. People get fined if they don't pay their taxes
7. If you tell me a secret, I never tell anyone else

First Conditional

1. If it rains, we will cancel the match
2. If a snake comes in to the house, I will scream and run away
3. If we take the train, we will arrive there sooner

4. Unless you help me, I won't finish his work
5. If I have the time, I will take you shopping
6. If it's a sunny day, we will go to the beach tomorrow
7. If I get lost, I will phone you
