

- Pasado Simple: they are actions or states that began and ended in a certain amount of time.
- Pasado continuo: Used to declare actions that are performed in the past.
- past perfect: it is used to express sequences of events in the past and to identify which occurred first.
- Past perfect continuo: this time is useful to define a continuous action in the past that happened before another.
- Conditional perfecto: it is used to express actions that could have occurred, but did not happen for some reason.
- continuos perfect conditional: like the perfect conditional, it expresses situations that would have occurred, but have a longer duration.
- present simple: this time is used to talk about actions that happen frequently, either daily or with specific periodicity.
- present continuo: they are actions or states that happen continuously or that are carried out just at the moment in which it is spoken.
- Present perfect; they are actions or states that began at some point of the past and that continue until the moment which it is spoken.

- present perfect continuous: this verb tense in English is for actions or states that have developed for a certain time that began in the past and continues at the time it is expressed
- conditional simple: express hypothetical situations in the present that would happen if it were not for a situation that prevents it.
- future simple: with this time actions or states are expressed that are thought spontaneously and will happen in the future.
- future continuous: they are states or actions that will have progress in the future.
- future perfect: these are states or actions that will be completed at some point in the future.
- future perfect continuous: it serves to express actions or states that will occur in the future, as well as its conclusion.
