

Passive and Active Voice.

Active voice

tells what a person or thing does. The subject performs the action and typically comes before the action (verb). The object is who or what receives the action and typically comes after the action verb.

es:

Camilo writes an essay

Passive voice

tells what is done to someone or something. The subject receives the action and typically comes after the action (verb). The object is who or what receives the action and typically comes before the action (verb).

es:

An essay is written by Camilo

Camila buys a ball → a ball is bought by Camila

The teacher reads a magazine. → a magazine is read by the teacher

Verb to be	
Present	am / is / are
Present Progressive	am being / is being / are being
Present Perfect	have been / has been
Past	was / were
Past Progressive	was being / were being
Past Perfect	had been
Future	will be

Passive voice:

- * the sun is revolved around by the earth.
- * a walk am go for by I.
- * a walk was used to go for by I.
- * a yesterday were played soccer by they.
- * a book was read yesterday by I.
- * genius is by I.
- * every Tuesday was played football by He.
- * Football was playing by He.
- * TV. right now is watching by he.
- * a dream ~~is~~ am living by I.
