The to be is a verb used to describe something or someone. The most common use of the to be verb is to talk about names, age, feeling, nationality and professions

Example

Name My name **is** Sara.

Age: I **am** 12 years old.

feeling: I **am** happ.

Nationally: My nationality **is** Colombian

Profesion: My profecion **is** student

Mary **is** Sad
The student **are** intelligent

Personal pronoun + Verb to be

• I am

• You are

• She is

• He is

• It is

• We are

• You are

• They are

Example • The Cat is beautiful

It is beautiful

• The doctors Are tired

They are tired

• Mary and Peter Are boyfriend

They Are boyfriend

• Mary is Punctual

She is Punctual

Example

The piano is big

It is big

Affirmative: She is happy

Negative: She is not happy
She isn't happy

Affirmative: We are engineers

Negative: We are not engineers / We aren't engineers

Question: Are We engineers?

Affirmative: Sara is small

Negative: Sara is not small / Sara isn't small

Question: Is Sara small

Affirmative the students are wise

Negative The student are not wise

Question: Are the students wise?

Is the teacher elegant?

Affirmative yes, the teacher is elegant

Negative Not, the teacher is not elegant

✓ Affirmative Walter is a baker

✓ Negative Walter is not a baker

✓ Question: Is walter a baker?

✓ Answer (A): Yes, Walter is a Baker

✓ Answer (N): Not, Walter is not a Baker
