A **Word** used to identify any of a class of PEOPLE, ANIMALS, Places, or Things.

for example

People: Sandy

Animals: Whale

Place: Bogota

Thing: Chair

Kinds of nouns

1 **Common nouns**: refer to people, places and things

Examples: teacher, car, music, danger, receipt

2 **Proper Nouns**: refer to names of people, places or organizations

Example: Jane, Thailand, Sunday, James Bond, Einstein, Superman,

Game of Thrones, Shakespear

3 Concrete Nouns: Concrete nouns are physical things that you can touch.
Example: man, rice, head, ear, furniture, mobile phone

4 Abstract Nouns: They are things that you cannot touch. Abstract nouns are ideas, concepts and feelings
Example: happiness, courage, danger, truth
