AFFIRMATIVE	Present Sujeto + am / is / are + (complemento)	She is fast.
	Past Sujeto + was / were + (complemento)	Mike was the best in his class.
NEGATIVE	Present Sujeto + am / is / are + not + (complemento)	You aren't at work.
	Past Sujeto + was / were + not + (complemento)	Jim and Laura weren't at the party.
INTERROGATIVE	Present Am / is / are + sujeto + (complemento)?	Are they at the party? Yes, they are.
	Past Was / were + sujeto + (complemento)?	Were they busy? Yes, they were.
