Present Simple

Different actions in the present

Auxiliary (Do)

Present simple is a verb tense which is used to show repetition, habit or generalization.

Only in the present.

Example: I sleep at night
 Paula reads a books
 Sophie eats hot dogs
 Peter and Juan study together at the school

Usage:

- Things are always true (scientific facts)

- Habits

Routines

- For situation that we think is more or less permanent.

- For short actions that are happening now.

Remember: Only the present simple

Present simple is formed by the subject, verb and complement.

Shakira sing so well

The teacher speaks spanish

The students listen to the English class.

The only variation is in the third person.

(She, He or It) Because you have to add "s", "HE" or "IES" to the verb.

Example

- Juana speaks spanish (speak)
- He watches TV, At night (watch)
- The students studies in the morning. (study)

Rule 1:

You have add "s" in third person: He, She, It.

She speaks

He reads

Rule 2:

When verb end with o, s, ch, sh, x or z, we add to es

miss miss + es = misses

Kiss Kiss + es = Kisses

Watch watch + es = watches

Rule 3:

When a verb end with "y" and there is a consonants before it, the "y" changes into "ies".

Fly Flies = Flies

Try tries = Tries

Cry cries = Cries

Study studies = Studies

Rule 4:

When a verbs ends with y, and there is a vowel before it, we simply add the letter s to verb.

Buy = Buys = buys

Say = Says = says

Pay = Pays = pays
