Superlative

A superlative is the form of an adjective or an adverb used to compare three or more things. The superlative form of an adjective is used to show something has a quality to the greatest or least degree.

Example:

- Johan Herrera is the tallest in the classroom.
- Peter is the most intelligent at the university.
- Camila is the smallest in her family.

Rules:

1. Adjectives with one or two syllables. You have to add "EST". You always use "the" before the adjective.

Example:

- Old - THE oldest
- Small - THE smallest.

2. Adjectives with one or two syllables that finish in "E". You only add "ST".

Example:

- Large - THE largeST.
- Humble - THE humbleST.

3. Adjectives with one or two syllables that finish in "y", You have to change "y" by "i" and add "EST".

Example:

- Busy - THE BusIEST
- Heavy - THE heavIEST.

4. Adjectives with one or two syllables that finish in consonant + vowel + consonant, You put doubled consonant and "EST".

Example:

- Big - THE bigGEST
- Fat - THE fatTEST

5. Adjectives with three or more syllables. You have to add "THE MOST" before the adjective.

- Interesting - THE MOST interesting
- Beautiful - THE MOST beautiful

Irregular adjectives for superlative:

Good - The best.

Bad - Worst.

Much - The most.

Little - The least.

Far - The furthest / the farthest.
