## Solution

### Too:

- That is too much.
- There is too much sugar
- There are too many people.
- The work is too hard.
- I don't have too much money.

### Enough:

- I don't have enough money to travel
- There is enough space for us.
- That car is not big enough for my family.
- I have enough time for my homework.
- I'm not bad enough to quite trying.



The particle *too* indicates excess, that is, the quantity or quality exceeds what is considered necessary.

### ENOUGH (suficiente / suficientemente / bastante)

The particle *enough* indicates that the quantity, number or quality of something is sufficient.
