Negative: be not used to

Example:

X They are used to learn english

✓ They are used to learning english

Speak French

I am used to speaking French

Sleep Early

I am used to sleeping early

Read a book per month

I am used to reading a book per month

Play guitar

I am used to playing guitar

Travel abroad

I am used to traveling abroad

Pay my bills

I am used to paying my bills

fight with my friends

I am used to fighting with my friends

I am used to going to the shopping

used to

used to + verb infinitive refers to a habit or state in the past

Example

+ I used to watch TV

- I didn't use to watch TV

? Did I use to watch TV?

Be used to: estás/estoy acostumbrado

Get used to: me estoy acostumbrando

used to: me había acostumbrado

Expression	Usage	Example
Be used to	estoy acostumbrado	I am used to playing soccer
Get used to	me estoy acostumbrando	I am get used to playing soccer
used to	me había acostumbrado	I am used to play soccer
