

Definition

Linker words or word connectors are used to link large groups of words, phrases and sentences. You can also use them to connect paragraphs to give them coherence.

Example: I love going to the cinema BUT I don't like eating popcorn.

Contrast

To spite of / despite links two contrasting ideas followed by a noun phrase.

Although / (even) though links two contrasting ideas followed by a sentence.

to wonder / nevertheless / still / yet / even so / on the contrary / in contrast

Introduce a new idea which marks a contrast with previously stated idea introduced by a comma.

On the one hand / on the other hand links two contrasting ideas / paragraphs.

Addition

moreover / furthermore / in addition / besides
whats more used after a strong point
and separated from the sentence. They
are introduced by a comma

As well as / in addition to / besides used to
add one more piece of information
followed by a noun phrase
