Present simple

uses:

1. We use the present simple when something is generally or always true.

Example: People need food.
It snows in winter here.
Two and two make four.
Students learn English.

2. We need to use this tense for a situation that we think is more or less permanent.

Examples: Where do you live?
She works in a bank.
I don't like mushrooms.
3. The next use is for habits or things that we do regularly.

Example: Do you smoke?
I play tennis every
Tuesday.
I don't travel very
often.

3. We can also use the present simple for short actions that are happening now. The actions are so short that they are finished almost as soon as you've said the sentence.

Examples: He takes the ball.
Students write in their
