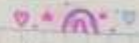

She was at the school.

Grand and Julia were here.

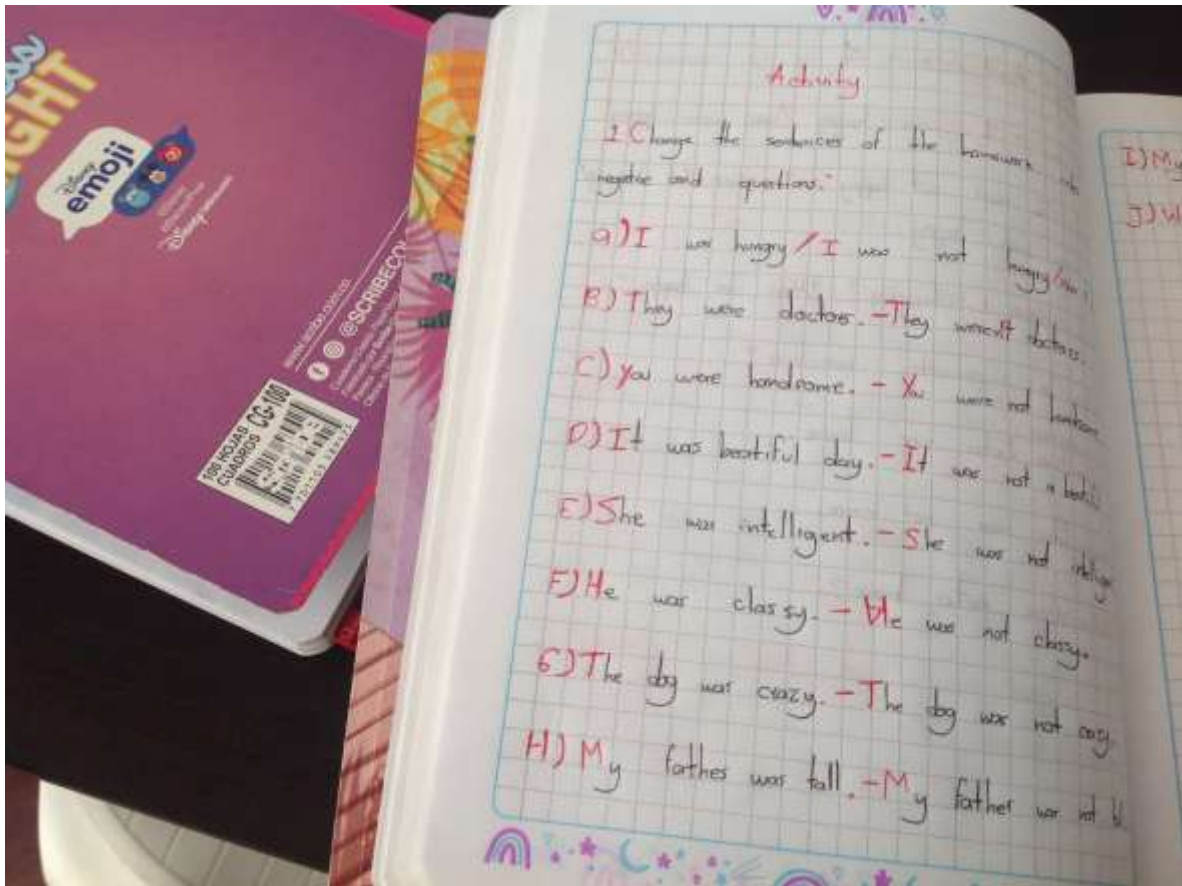
