

Past perfect

- 1 He (not/be) hadn't been to Cape Town before 1997
- 2 when she went out to play, she had done already her homework
- 3 My brother ate all of the cake that our mum had made
- 4 The doctor took off the plaster that he had put on six weeks before
- 5 The waiter brought a drink that I hadn't ordered.
- 6 I could not remember the poem we had learned the week before
- 7 The children collected the chestnuts that had fallen from the tree
- 8 had he phoned angie before he went to see her in London?
- 9 she hadn't ridden a horse before that day

Past simple - past perfect

- After Fred had spent (to spend) his holiday in Italy he wanted (to want) to learn Italian
- Jill had phoned dad at work before she left for her trip
- Susan turned on the radio after she had washed the dishes
- when she arrived the match had already started
- After the man had come home he fed the cat
- Before he sang a song he played the guitar
- she watched watch a video after the children had gone (go)

- After Eric had made breakfast he phoned his friend
- I was (to be) very tired because I had studied too much
- They had ridden their bikes before they met their friends
