Negative form

Subject + **had** + **Not** + Verb / Participle + complement

Juan **had not** spoken english with his friends
They had **Not** written to family a letter about their situation
Juan **hadn't** spoken english with his friends
You can write had not or hadn't
Laura / understand / the lesson
Laura had not understood the lesson
