

BE used to, Get used to, used to

BE used to.

If you are used to something, you have often done or experienced it, it is not strange, new or difficult for you

I am used to getting up early in the morning; don't mind it.

Structure = Be used to + noun phrase or verb (-ing form)

He didn't complain about the neighbours' loud party - he was used to the noise

We can also say be used to someone

I don't think Tom's strange - I'm used to him

Negative: be not used to

I don't understand him; I'm not used to his accent yet

I Am used to speaking English
she is used to sleeping early.

They are used to learning English
He is used to playing attention.

Examples

Speak French - I am used to speaking French

Sleep Early - she is used to sleeping early

Read A Book per month - I am used to reading a book per month

Play Guitar - I am used to playing guitar

Travel Abroad - I am used to travelling abroad.

Pay my bills - I am used to paying my bills

Fight with my friends - I am used to fighting with my friends.

Go to the shopping - I am used to going to the shopping

Eat rice - I am used to eating rice

Listen to the Radio - I am used to listening to radio.

GET used to structure

get used to + something / someone

get used to + verb (-ing form)

<p>If you get used to something you become accustomed to it; it is no longer unusual or strange</p>	<p>I got used to his Scottish accent after a while</p>
<p>Get used to is the process of becoming used to something</p>	<p>I got used to watching up early in the morning after a while he didn't mind the noise in the office; he got used to it</p>

Examples

Speak french - I got used to speaking french

sleep early - she gets used to sleeping early

read a book - per month she gets used to read a book per month

play guitar - I got used to playing guitar

travel abroad - I got used to traveling abroad

pay my bills - I get used to paying my bills

fight with my friends - she gets used to going to the shopping

go to the shopping - I get used to going to the shopping

eat rice - he gets used to eating rice

listen to the radio - I get used to listening to the radio

Used to

Used to verb infinitive refers to a habit or state in the past. It is used only in the past simple tense

If you used to do something, you did it for a period of time in the past, but you don't do it any more Past habits

We also say used to express a state that existed in the past, but doesn't exist now. States are not actions. We express states with stative verbs such as have, believe, know and like Past states

did (not) + subject + used to be
