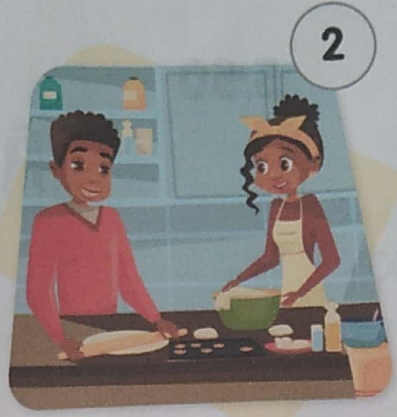


Activity
