To the base form of most verbs

start → started

Finish → finished

wash → washed

### 2 Add only -d

When the base form ends in an e

care - cared

die - died

3 If the verb ends in a consonant + y, change the y to i and add -ed

Dry - dried

Carry - carried

spy - spied

4 If the verb ends in a vowel + y, do not change the y, just add -ed (pray)

pray - prayed

stay - stayed

Destroy - destroyed

If the verb has one syllable and ends in a

Consonant + vowel + consonant (CVC).

Double the final consonant and add -ed.

Stop - stopped

Do not double final w or x

Sew - sewed

Mix - mixed

Meet - met

Drive - drove

Speak - spoke

Put - put

Write - wrote

Sing - sang

Do - did

Sit - sat

Stand - stood

Run - ran
