PAST SIMPLE

Is A Verb Tense Which Is Used To Show That A Completed Action Took Place At A Specific Time In The Past. The Simple Past Is Also Frequently Use To Talk About Past Habits And Generalization.

Example: Camilo Played Soccer With His Friends Yesterday.
Peter Studied English The Last A Year.
Students Wrote An Essay Yesterday.
Luisa Ate Rice With Milk The Last Week.

Past Simple Tense:

We Use The Past Tense To Talk About:

- 1) Something That Happened Once In The Past.
- 2) Something That Happened Again And Again In The Past.
- 3) Something That Was True For Some Time In The Past.

NEGATIVE

Rick wasn't fat last year.
They weren't schoolmates ten years ago.
Was Rick fat last year?

INTERROGATIVE

Yes, he was.
No, he wasn't.
Were they schoolmates ten years ago?
Yes, they were.
No, they weren't.
