Object pronouns

We use the object pronoun when the objects are what is affected by the action of the subject

I read books (Books is the object as it is receiving the action)

I read them

Possessive adjectives

The possessive adjective needs to agree with the possessor and not with the thing that is possessed

My car is very old

Possessive Pronouns

We can use a possessive pronoun instead of a full noun phrase to avoid repeating words:

Is that John's car? No, it's mine
