subject + will + verb (base form) + complement

- I will travel to Mexico in three years

## Negative

subject + will not (won't) + verb (base form) + complement

- I won't travel to Mexico in three years

## Question

will + subject + verb (base form) + complement + ?

- Will I travel to Mexico in three years
