Is a verb tense which is used to show that a completed action took place at a specific time in the past. The simple past is also frequently used to talk about past habits and generalization.

Examples: I studied at the university the last year.  
I went to German the last vacation.  
I visited my parents yesterday.  
She traveled to USA two years ago.

## Past Simple Tense

We use the past tense to talk about:

- 1) Something that happened once in the past.
- 2) Something that happened again and again in the past.
- 3) Something that was true for some time in the past.

Examples: I lived abroad for ten years

He enjoyed being a student

to the base form of most verbs

start - started

finish - finished

wash - washed

### 2 Add only - d

When the base form ends in an e.

love - loved

care - cared

die - died

3 If the verb ends in a consonant + y change the

y to i and add - ed

Dry - Dried

carry - carried

spy - spied

4. If the verb ends in a vowel - y do not change the y. Just add - ed

Pray - played

stay - stayed

destroy - destroyed

5. If the verb has one syllable and ends in consonant + vowel + consonant double the final consonant and add - ed stop - stopped

6. Do not double final

w or x

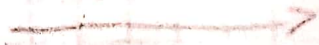

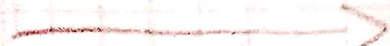

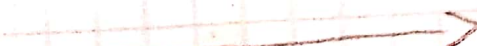
