### 1. Answer the questions

a) what is a connector? Give example

R/: A connector is a word or set of words that you use to join phrases or sentences. The function of these words is that by using them correctly they help us to better organize what we say and what we write

Example: I think she is the best candidate for the job

B) what is a linking word? Give an example

R/: Are simply words and expressions that tie whole sentences, phrases, or individual elements together to establish a smooth transition in a text. The term "linking" means "connecting" and stands for cohesion.

Example: That is the place where I feel good

C) what are the differences between connector and linking word

R/: Conjunctions grammatically join two clauses so that it reads as one sentence. Connectors are used between two separate sentences.
