Affirmative Peter and Walter travel to China

Negative doesn't Peter and Walter travel to China

## Negative statements

Subject + Auxiliary (negative) + verb (infinitive)  
I do not study English / I do not study English  
She does not study English  
We do not study English / We do not study English

Remember: For I / do not

- 4) Uncle George doesn't meet in front of
- 5) Our friends doesn't play football in
