On: Use on with the names of days or dates

On Thursday / On morning Monday / On new year's day

On weekend / On Sundays / On a weekend

In: Use in with period of time (but not with names of days)

In 1998 / In July / In (The) Spring

in the morning / in the 20th century / in the 1960's

At: Use at with specific moment in time

At 9:00 / At ten-thirty-five / At 6:00

At sunrise / at noon / at midnight

Of place

On: Use on with the names of streets and specific physical locations

On main street / on Smith Avenue
