to the base form of most  
verbs

Start - Started

Finish - Finished

Wash - Washed

2) - Add only -d

when the base form  
ends in an e

Live - Lived

Care - Cared

Die - Died

3) - if the verb ends

in a consonant + y

change the y to i and  
add -ed dry

Carry - Carried

Spy - Spied

4) - if the verb ends

in a vowel + y, do

not change the y  
just add -ed

pray - prayed

Destroy - Destroyed

Stay - Stayed

5) - if the verb has one

syllable and ends in

a consonant + vowel + consonant

(CVC)

Stop - stopped
