He jumped back into the taxi and told the driver to take him home. The driver drove quickly and Martin arrived back at his house in twenty minutes.


He ran into the house and went into his bedroom. He found his passport on the bedside table and left the house again. But the taxi wasn't there! Where was the taxi!



IST PROGRESSIVE

he past progressive (or past continuous) is used for actions that were happening at a specific ime in the past. Like the present continuous, it is formed with the auxiliary verb "to be" and the erb + ing.

oform the past progressive, the auxiliary verb "to be" and the verb + ing are used. The auxiliary erb "to be" is in the past simple, but keep in mind that "to be" is an irregular verb.

	STRUCTURE	EXAMPLES
AFFIRMATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	When I saw them they were sitting at a café.
NEGATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + not + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	What did you say? I wasn't listening.
INTERROGATIVE	Was / Were + sujeto + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)?	What were you talking about?
