Sean Connery was born in Scotland in 1930. He left school at an early age and when he was sixteen, he joined the Navy. He had many jobs including laborer, lifeguard, model for art classes, bricklayer and milkman. Sean was interested in body building and he participated in the 1953 Mr. Universe Contest, in which he came 3rd.
