subject + auxiliary (negative) + verb (infinitive) + complement.

I don't study English / I do not study English

She doesn't study English / she does not study English.

Remember for (I/you/we/they): do for she/he/it: Does

Auxiliary + subject + verb (infinitive) + complement?

Do you study English?

(+) you travel to Paris every year.

(-) you don't travel to Paris every year.

(?) Do you travel to Paris every year?
