Too *

"too" means more than what is needed

- Too + Adj / Adv...

- It's too hot to wear that coat

- I was driving too fast.

- Too Much + Uncountable Nouns

- There is too much salt in this food

- Too Many + Countable Nouns

- There are too many students in this classroom

Enough

Enough *

"Enough" means sufficient.

• Adj / Adv + Enough

• He isn't old enough to watch this program

• We're not walking quickly enough.

• Enough + Noun

• We have enough money.

• I have not got enough money to buy this computer.

Example.

I left the coffee for a minute to cool because it was (too) hot to drink

1. He wasn't strong enough to lift that heavy box.

2. There aren't too policemen in our town

3. Do you have too information to help me with this problem?

4. It is too difficult to do for a little child.

5. I do not have too much time to prepare dinner.

6. I didn't buy the car because it was enough expensive.

7. He didn't work hard enough to pass the exams.

8. My mum can't sleep because she drinks too much coffee.

9. She isn't old enough to start driving.

The particle **enough** indicates that the quantity, number or quality of something is sufficient.
