

(Too or enough)

- 1 I left the coffee for a minute to cool because it was too hot to drink.
- 2 He wasn't strong enough to lift that heavy box.
- 3 There aren't enough policemen in our town.
- 4 Do you have enough information to help me with?
- 5 It is too difficult to do for a little child.
- 6 I do not have too much time to prepare dinner.

Example

1. Maria is clever enough to take this decision.
2. I am too old to understand this music.

When are too and enough used?

TOO (demasiado)

The particle **too** indicates excess, that is, the quantity or quality exceeds what is considered necessary.

ENOUGH (suficiente / suficientemente / bastante)

The particle **enough** indicates that the quantity, number or quality of something is sufficient.
