When are too and enough used?

TOO (demasiado)

The particle too indicates excess, that is, the quantity or quality exceeds what is considered necessary.

ENOUGH (suficiente / suficientemente / bastante)

The particle enough indicates that the quantity, number or quality of something is sufficient.
