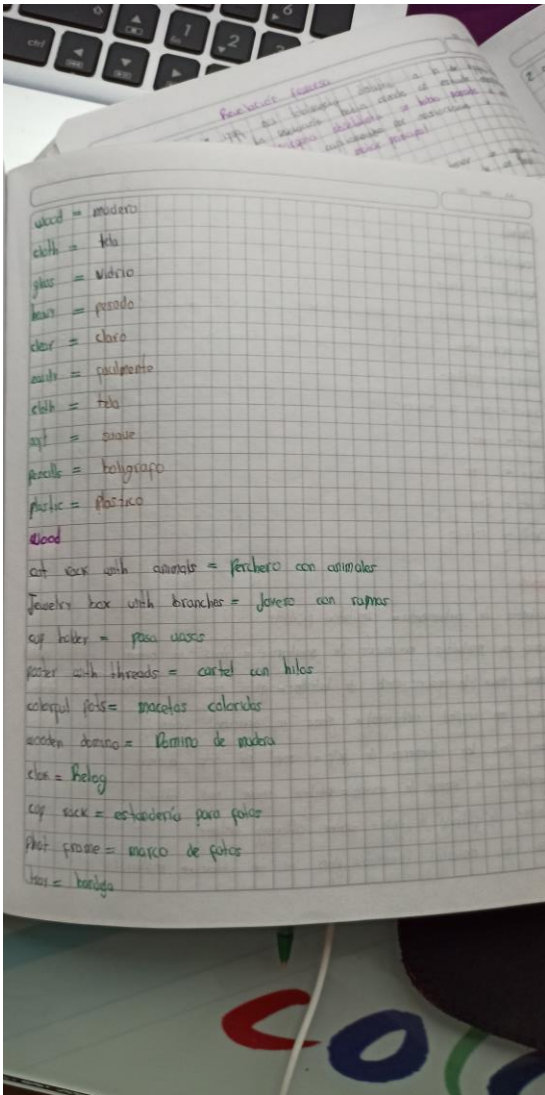


Materials

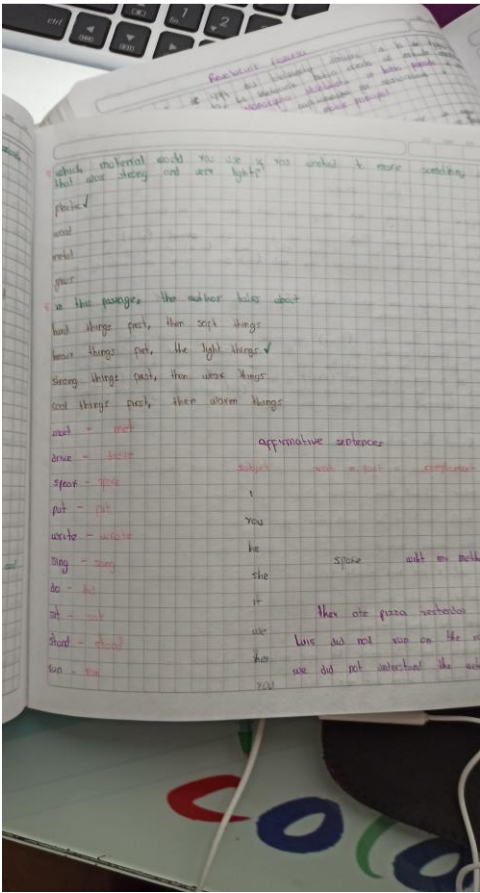
