water freezes IF the temperature
goes below 0°C

IF + present simple
present simple

warning ↙

first conditional

IF I have some free time
I will change Netflix



I will change the wifi password
IF you don't do your homework

IF + present simple
will result

third conditional

IF + past perfect, would have (v participle form)

zero conditional

- 1 my teacher gets angry when I don't do (not/to do) my homework
- 2 my little sister cries if she has (to have) a nightmare
- 3 when you drink too much alcohol, you get (to get) drunk
- 4 if you mix blue and yellow, you get (to get) green
- 5 if you don't drink enough water, you become (become) dehydrated
- 6 people get fined if they don't pay (not/to pay) their taxes
- 7 if you tell me a secret, I never tell (to tell) anyone else

First conditional!

- 1 IF it rains, we will cancel (to cancel) the match
- 2 IF a snake come into the house, I will scream (to scream) and run away
- 3 IF take the van, we will arrive (to arrive) there sooner
- 4 unless you help me, I don't finish (not / to finish) this work
- 5 IF I have the time, I will take (to take) you shopping
- 6 IF it is a sunny day, we will go (to go) to the beach tomorrow
- 7 IF I get lost, I will phone (to phone) you
