1 or more things.

Anna is the smallestest in class
this book is the most interesting.

Rules of Superlative:

One of superlative:

one syllables:

You have to add //est// to the
adjective.

Short - shortest

Weak - weakest

Tall - tallest

one syllable and finish //e//

When the adjective finishes in
//e// you only add //s//

Large-Largest

Nice-Nicest

Two syllables and finish in "y"
When the adjectives in "y" you
have to change "y" by "i" and
add "est"

Ugly-ugliest

Busy-busiest

Three or more syllables

When the adjective has 3 or
more syllables, you have to write
"most" before the adjective.

Expensive-most expensive

Beautiful-most beautiful

Dangerous-most dangerous

Important-most important

Remember: When you use superlative
form, you have to write "the"
before adjective.

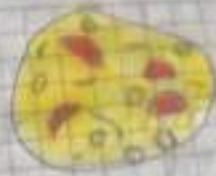

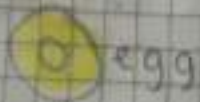

1) THIS - Near / Singular: (this is my notebook)

2) THESE - Near / plural: (these are my notebooks)

3) THAT - Far / Singular: (that is my notebook)

4) THOSE - Far / plural: (those are my notebooks)

THIS: Esta / este

THESE: Estos

THAT: Aquel

THOSE: Aquellos

This is my car (near / singular)

Those are my teachers (far / plural)

That is my pencil (far / singular)

Those are my markets (far / plural)
