**AFFIRMATIVE**

Rick was fat last year.  
They were schoolmates ten years ago.  
Rick wasn't fat last year.  
They weren't schoolmates ten years ago.  
Was Rick fat last year?

**NEGATIVE**

Yes, he was.  
No, he wasn't.  
Were they schoolmates ten years ago?  
Yes, they were.  
No, they weren't.

**INTERROGATIVE**
